HE RANCH -

Coyote Ridge Ranch LLC is a working commercial cow/calf ranching operation in the beautiful, natural state of Arkansas, just outside of Mulberry. The ranch encompasses approximately 1,200 acres in its operation, offering picturesque views, river front meadows, primitive rock scapes, mature timber, and a source of production for:

•Commercial beef cattle - Primarily F1 Braford replacement females •American Quarter Horses - Hancock/Blue Valentine bloodlines, and •Bermuda/native grass hay

CATTLE -

As a production center for commercial beef cattle, we employ natural growth rather than hormones,

through maternal efficiency rather than grain, to yield satisfactory weaning weights.

We are an all natural beef production center. Our ranch operates a cow/calf operation with management practices of no growth hormones, all natural feeds, and an extremely minimal use of antibiotics. Over the years, we have migrated to the use of females with a heavy influence of Brahman genetics. As a result, our current herd is





predominately F1 Brahman - cross cows bred to Charolais bulls. We have found these Brahman influenced females to be more heat resistant, have a longer production life, generate more milk production and wean heavier calves.

With the demand for F1 Braford replacement heifers being so great, we have increased the number of purebred and registered Brahman females to supply the increasing demand of replacement females.



ORSES -

In addition to cattle, we also produce a handful of exceptional American Quarter Horses each year. The core of our program consists of twenty carefully selected females, all offering the genetic influence of AQHA Hall of Fame racehorse, Joe Hancock, through his grandson, Blue Valentine.

Our horses are the product of a specific set of genetics based on the premise of versatility. For decades,

the American Quarter Horse maintained a broad skill set for usefulness at a variety of tasks which promoted the breed to its global popularity. That ideology is the basis for every planned mating. With genetic strength a focus of Coyote Ridge Ranch horses, all blood stock have been genetic health tested for the five inherited diseases now testable among all stock horses.

AY/SUPPLEMENTS -

As the case with most ranching operations, forage production is equally important. Hay production that exceeds the needs of the ranch is offered for sale. In 2008, the ranch began using Feed In A Drum products exclusively and became an authorized dealer in 2010. These products are nutrient dense, weather resistant, free choice, mineral and vitamin fortified supplements that also provide added savings compared to traditional feeding practices that are both fuel and labor intensive.

The FlaxLic® is the ranch's favorite among the product line with its all-natural supplement that contains a high level of Alpha-linolenic acid (ALA), an omega-3 fatty acid. With 12% protein, through virtually no cereal grains and 15% fat, derived predominantly from flaxseed and edible linseed (flaxseed) oil, FlaxLic® offers increased fertility and increased immune function in both cattle and horses.
